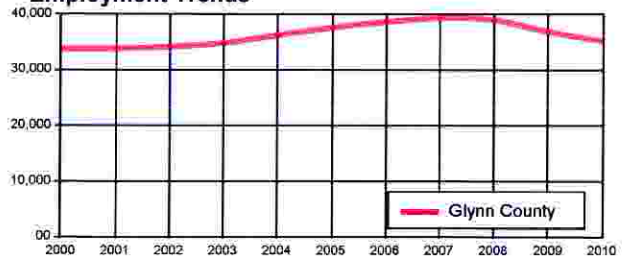

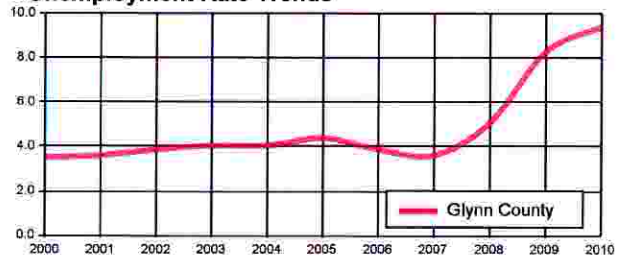

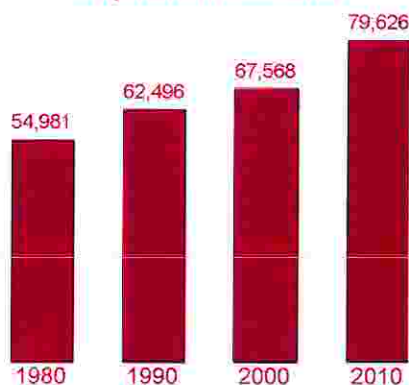
### Employment Trends

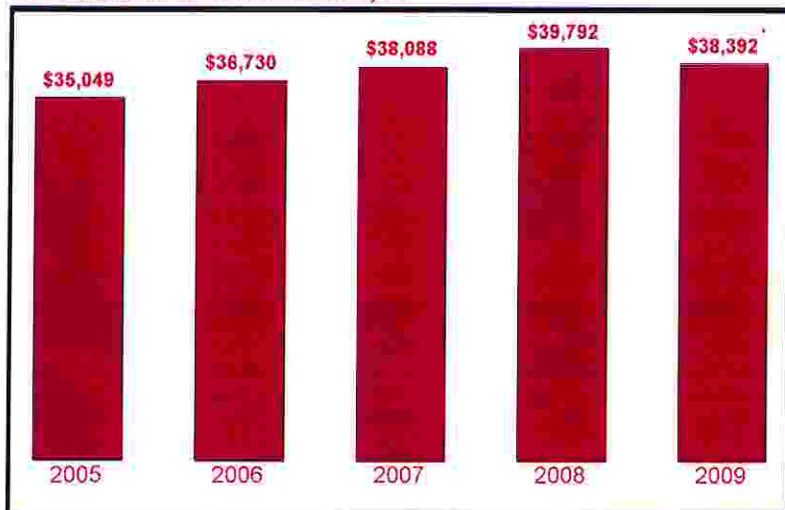

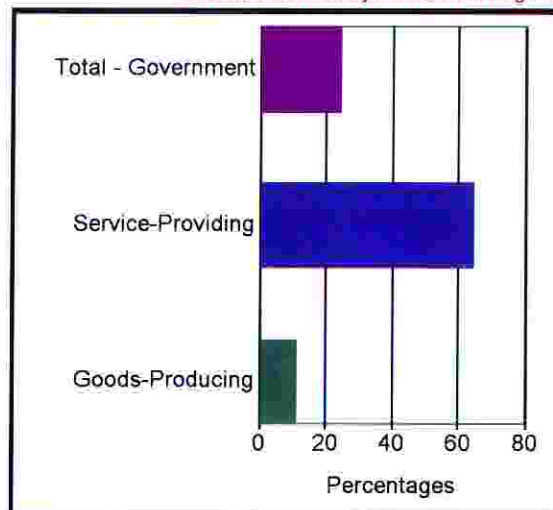
## Glynn Per Capita Income
